West Middle School is proud to host three nights in the spring for honoring student achievements. The purpose of our annual awards nights is to recognize students who show outstanding academic growth and unusual commitment to their academics, often in spite of obstacles. Though the primary indicators of excellence may be based on academic achievement, teachers have the opportunity to recognize student performance that demonstrates citizenship, respect, equity, motivation, initiative, creativity, intellectual depth, leadership and/or exceptional judgment. Exceptional students may not always be those with the highest overall grades; they may be the student leaders who have had an extraordinary year of growth.

CORE AND ELECTIVE C.A.R.E. AWARDS:

Teachers determine the final awardees based on one or more of the following criteria:

- a. High overall grade and level of academic scholarship
- b. Demonstration of the C.A.R.E. motto (Citizenship, Achievement, Respect, Equity)
- c. Class participation
- d. Consistency of performance and depth of intellect
- e. Range of improvement, aspires to high goals
- f. Overcoming setbacks or obstacles to achievement
- g. Devotion to learning as seen through motivation, initiative, and creativity
- h. Sharing academic talent with others in cooperative learning environments leadership and/or exceptional judgment
- i. Behind the scenes treatment of other students to benefit their learning
